Section 2: Installation Preparation



Section 3: Installation on Mounting Platform

Installation Instructions for Light Duty Fairfield Rails (LRS) and Fairfield Horizontal Rails (FRS)




WARNING: DO NOT MOUNT THE FTA(-__)-__(_) ABOVE THE PATIENT'S HEAD.



WARNING: ENSURE RAILING IS STABLE AND PROPERLY INSTALLED BEFORE MOUNTING FTA(-__)-__(_).

- 1. Locate a compatible rail.
- 2. Determine the position that FTA(-__)-__(_) will mount to on the rail. (Figure 3)
- 3. Install FTA (-__)-__(_) by wedging the top groove of FTA (-__)-__(_) into the top grove of the rail. (Figure 4)
- 4. Press FTA (-__)-__(_) into the rail by pushing the bottom end. (Figure 5)
- 5. Tighten 2x H-HSSS-71620-38 to secure the 2x W-X-BALL-375-NY onto the bottom groove of the rail. (Figure 6)
- 6. Check FTA(-__)-__(_) to ensure it is securely mounted by pulling up/down on it and ensuring it does not pull off the rail.









WARNING: THE FTA-05 AND FTA-8-32 HAVE A MAXIMUM LOAD RATING OF 2.5 LB.FT, APPROXIMATELY 15 LBS, 2 INCHES FROM THE CENTER OF THE CROSS SECTION OF THE MOUNTING SURFACE OF THE ADAPTER. HENCE THE TOTAL WEIGHT OF ALL THE EQUIPMENT ATTACHED SHOULD NOT EXCEED 15 LBS. ATTACHING MORE WEIGHT CAN LEAD TO FAILURE AND HENCE CAUSE DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT AND/OR INJURIES TO PEOPLE NEARBY.

Section 4: Device Installation

For FTA-8-32

- 1. Align device with 2x #8-32 clearance holes with FTA-8-32's threaded holes as shown in Step 1. (Figure 7)
- 2. It is recommended to apply thread sealant or add lock washers to the screws.
- 3. Screw device into FTA-8-32 to secure as shown in Step 2. (Figure 7)



For FTA-05

- 1. Turn H-THUMB-KNOB-34 counter-clockwise to loosen and allow clearance in the hole to slide the device with 0.5" diameter post into FTA-X-05-SOCKET as shown in Step 1. (Figure 8)
- 2. Set the device to desired height (slide the device slowly to allow enough post to be tightened in FTA-05, limited by device post length).
- 3. Secure device in FTA-05 with H-THUMB-KNOB-34 by turning it clockwise as shown in Step 2. (Figure 8)



WARNING: CARE MUST BE TAKEN WHILE ADJUSTING THE DEVICE SO AS NOT TO DISLODGE AND DROP THE DEVICE FROM THE FTA-05.

Section 5: Adjustments

Adjust Device

To adjust the device on FTA-05, loosen H-THUMB-KNOB-34 by turning it counter-clockwise, adjust FTA-05 device to desired height (slide the device slowly and ensure enough post is tightened by H-THUMB-KNOB-34) and rotate H-THUMB-KNOB-34 in a clockwise direction to lock the device position. (**Figure 9**)

Adjust on Rail

To adjust FTA(-__)-__(_)'s position on the rail, loosen 2x H-HSSS-71620-38 at the bottom and slide FTA(-__)-__(_) left or right to the desired position and tighten 2x H-HSSS-71620-38 to lock FTA(-__)-__(_) in place. (Figure 9)



Troubleshooting

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution	
Device on FTA-05 is loose	Knob has loosened	Tighten knob, if problem persists, please contact Amico Accessories	
FTA-05, FTA-8-32 adapter is loose/unable to mount to Light Duty Fairfield Rail or Fairfield Horizontal Rail	Incorrect rail adapter/damaged rail adapter	Please contact Amico Accessories	
Device on FTA-8-32 is loose	8-32 screws have loosened	Tighten screws, if problem persists, please contact Amico Accessories

Cleaning

WARNING: PLEASE DO NOT SPRAY ANY CHEMICALS DIRECTLY ONTO THE FAIRFIELD HORIZONTAL RAIL ADAPTER. APPLY ONTO A SOFT CLOTH AND WIPE CLEAN TO PREVENT CHEMICALS GETTING INTO THE INTERNAL COMPONENTS OF THE FAIRFIELD HORIZONTAL RAIL ADAPTER.

The mounting assembly may be cleaned with most mild, non-abrasive solutions commonly used in the hospital environment (e.g. diluted bleach, ammonia, or alcohol solutions). The surface finish will be permanently damaged by strong chemical and solvent such as acetone and trichloroethylene. Steel wool or other abrasive material should never be used. Damaged caused by the use of unapproved substances or processes will not be warranted. It is recommended that you test any cleaning solution on a small area of the Fairfield Horizontal Rail Adapter that is not visible to verify compatibility. Never submerge the Fairfield Horizontal Rail Adapter and do not allow liquids to enter it. Wipe any cleaning agents off the Fairfield Horizontal Rail Adapter immediately using a water-dampened cloth. Dry the Fairfield Horizontal Rail Adapter thoroughly after.

Warranty
