Safety Instructions

Intended Use

The Lunar Series Decorative Night Light offers gentle, low-level lighting to support healthcare settings, enabling clinical staff to move through dark rooms without disrupting patients' rest. Designed to suit various patient sleep patterns, these night lights come in soft white options (2700K, 3000K, 3500K, and 4000K), along with amber and blue color choices. Featuring a unique, low-profile faceplate for a sleek look and balanced light diffusion, the Lunar Series LED Night Lights can be operated manually via a switch or set to activate automatically in low-light conditions using photocell technology.

User Profiles

No modifications can be carried out by the end user. Doing so will void warranty, ETL approval, and may cause severe risks. Serviceable parts must be replaced with factory OEM parts. The user must comply with all building safety codes and disinfection requirements.

Tools/Materials Required

- 1. Philips screwdriver
- 2. Single gang electrical box for wall installation
- 3. Torx screwdriver (for Behavioral VR)

Note: Before proceeding with the installation, make sure to remove the power to the electrical power supply.



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This installation manual is based on the use of a single gang box for clarity and ease of understanding. In actual application, the gang box will be installed within the wall.

1 Screw the ground wire ring terminal to the ground of the junction box.

> **NOTE:** Recommended wall cut-out is minimum of 3.2" x 2" (81.3 mm x 50.8 mm) and a maximum of 4" x 2.3" (101.6 mm x 58.4 mm).



2 Connect power supply to the fixture wires (input wires [Brown = Line; Blue = Neutral]) using correct size wire nuts determined by gauge of wire.



NOTE: Correct Polarity must be observed in order for the switch to operate. The Master Controller can be severely damaged by reverse polarity. Ensure that all electrical connections are secured properly and have proper connection.

3 Mount the mounting plate directly to junction box (provided by others) using the 6-32 -3/16" screws included with the junction box.



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4 Hook the faceplate slot onto the tab located on the top of the base plate. The tab of the base plate should sit fully inside the slot of the front cover. If not, then loosen the mounting screw on the base plate, and adjust the base plate to the correct position.






Mount the faceplate onto the flange at the bottom of the base plate by using the countersink m3x0.5 screw (supplied with fixture) or Torx screw for behavioral VR (supplied with fixture).




6 Ensure the faceplate is locked in place.
This is achieved when the countersunk screw is flush with faceplate.






